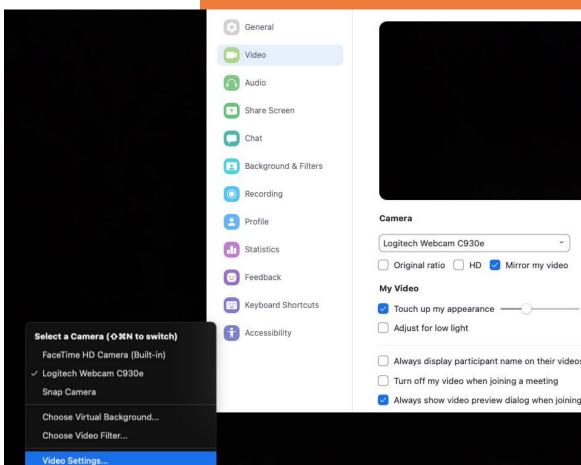

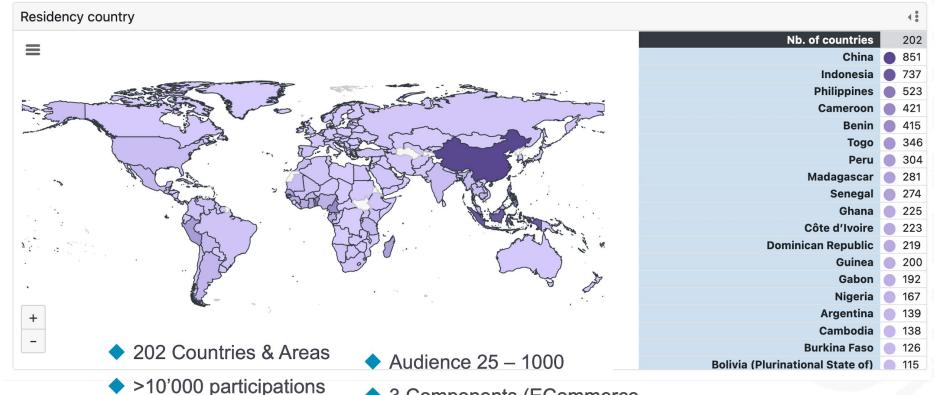

#### **KEEP YOUR PROJECT RUNNING - DIGITALISE**

- BRAINSTORMING SESSIONS
- Pre-sessions one-on-one with lead experts
- Test technology with different scenarios (high-low capacity)
- In between "live" sessions extra work
- Keep it short (max 70') and spread it (3 sessions)
  - ASSESSMENT PANELS
  - Time factor 2 days vs 2 weeks!
  - Need more resources (people)
  - Timely availability of experts (tracking through WhatsApp, Signal, Viber)
  - Discipline

#### **KEEP YOUR PROJECT RUNNING - DIGITALISE**

- SEMINARS, WORKSHOPS AND SIMILARS
- Collect registration data (know your audience!)
- Forum and moderation with experts!
- Follow up webinars
- Showcase selected participants experience/cases
- Increase participation using social media campaigns (timing and frequency)





- Reverse time factor: More time in preparation than actual event
- Set as many intermediary meetings as necessary
- Change language and style!
- Incentives
- Test, test and test (3x)





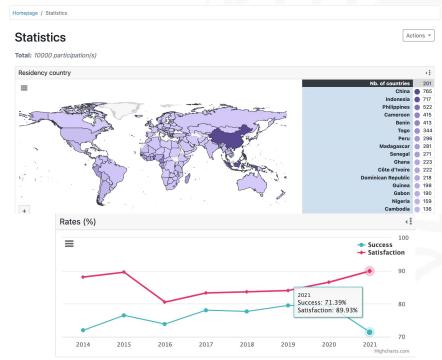




# LOOKING AT THE BENEFITS OF IT

**KNOW YOUR LIMITS** 

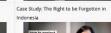
Digital tools & technology can boost your performance but will NOT replace resources, ability and time

- Easy to **record and disseminate** the session





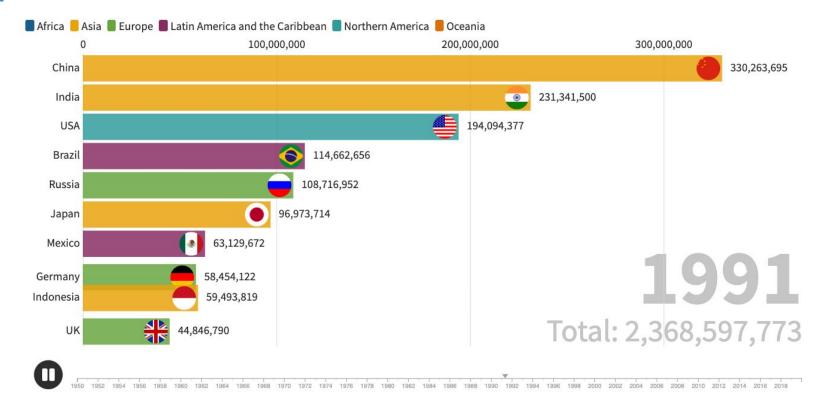

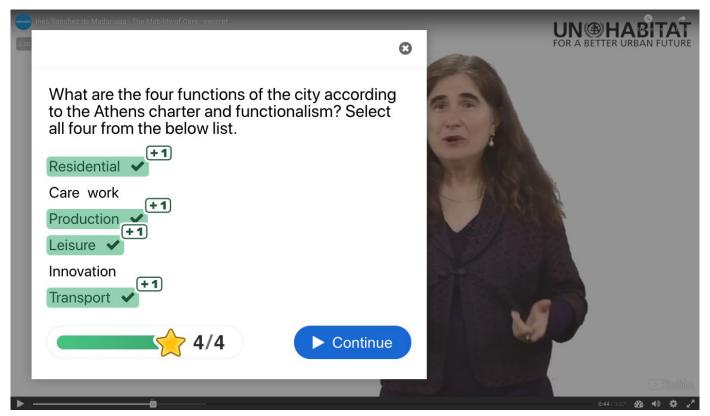

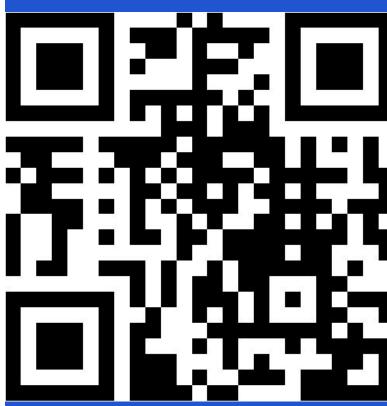
